Poster Guidelines: Your poster presentation should be related to nursing education, although clinical studies that advance the art or science of evidence-based nursing are also welcomed. Of special interest are abstracts that address special learning needs of nursing students, creative clinical experiences, student success strategies, clinical simulation, pharmacology teaching ideas, and e-learning. Abstracts will be peer-reviewed.

Guidelines for submission

- ♦ Title
- Author(s) and contact information include all authors' names, credentials and titles as you would like them to appear in the conference notebook
- Summary of project or study methodology
- ♦ Limitations/Conclusions
- Implications for nursing educational practice
- ♦ Bibliography
- Two objectives with content outline that participant can successfully met after reviewing your poster.

For example: *After reviewing this poster, the attendee will be able to:*

Objective 1: Review the purpose of testing.

- a. Purpose of testing
- b. Evaluation
- c. Validation
- d. Learning tool

Objective 2: Identify the process of writing test items that stimulate critical thinking and clinical decision-making.

 - Discriminating distracters
 - b. Alternate item format

- c. Level of difficulty
- d. Consistency in format
- e. Use of terminology i.e. patient, client, abbreviations

Any submissions that do not meet the required guidelines will not be accepted for review.

- 2. You will be contacted regarding your submission within 2 weeks. If this time elapses, please contact Deanne. Check your email, including the "junk" box...sometimes the confirmation ends up here ©.
- 3. More than one abstract may be submitted from an author/group of authors.
- 4. Students are encouraged to submit poster abstracts.
- 5. Presenters at the conference will receive a poster presentation certificate.
- 6. You must be a registered attendee in order to participate as a poster presenter.
- 7. You will be provided with a draped table approximately 6' by 18" for your poster.
- 8. Prepare your poster to stand alone as a table top display or you can place Velcro on the back of your laminated poster and it can be stuck to the air wall in the conference room. There will be no wall or backdrop on which to lean or hang your poster. The exact size of the poster doesn't matter it needs to fit on a 6' x 2' table.
- 9. Presenters are expected to be available for questions and discussion with participants during posted exhibit/poster session hours. Handouts and your contact information are recommended for attendees but not required.
- 10. Poster exhibit times are the same times as exhibit hall and break times which are outlined in the brochure.
